Windhoek / Swakopmund - Etosha National Park - Windhoek / Swakopmund

Departure Daily on request: 4 days/3 nights

Day 1: Windhoek - Etosha National Park.

(app. 420 km tarred road – app. 5 hours driving time)

Your experienced safari-guide will fetch you from your hotel in Windhoek and you depart at around 08h30 from Windhoek towards Okahandja, via Outjo (where possibly more clients might join the tour) into the famous Etosha National Park, where we'll undertake our first game drives. (lunch enroute excluded) The Park is well known for its huge herds of antelope and zebra.

Standard Version: Overnight with dinner, bed and breakfast at Etosha Safari Camp or similar. Superior Version: Overnight with dinner, bed and breakfast at Halali Resort or one of the privately owned lodges just outside the Van Lindequist Gate.

Or

Day 1: Swakopmund – Etosha National Park.

(app. 550 km tarred road – app. 6 hours driving time)

Your experienced safari-guide will fetch you from your hotel in Swakopmund and you depart at around 08h30 from Swakopmund via Omauru, Otjiwarongo and Outjo (where possibly more clients might join the tour) into the famous Etosha National Park, where we'll undertake our first game drives. (lunch enroute excluded) The Park is well known for its huge herds of antelope and zebra.

Standard Version: Overnight with dinner, bed and breakfast at Etosha Safari Camp or similar. Superior Version: Overnight with dinner, bed and breakfast at Halali Resort or one of the privately owned lodges just outside the Van Lindequist Gate.

Day 2: Etosha National Park.

A full day in the Park lies ahead of us. Except for the rainy season, Etosha's animals are depending on artificial waterholes and natural springs. Explore the various waterholes along this enormous saltpan. Lunch stop at one of the rest camps (lunch excluded). Encounter the big variety of wildlife in the Park during the course of the morning. More than 114 mammals species are found in the Park, several of them are rare and endangered like the black rhino of the black faced impala. You have a great chance of seeing some of the bigger mammals, like elephant and rhino and of course a highlight in any safari, the predators.

Standard Version: Overnight with dinner, bed and breakfast at Etosha Safari Camp or similar. Superior Version: Overnight with dinner, bed and breakfast at Halali Resort or one of the privately owned lodges just outside the Van Lindequist Gate.

Day 3: Etosha National Park.

Another full day in the Park lies ahead of us. We will drive along the vast saltpan, which is called the "great white place of dry water" in a local language. In some years, after heavy rain falls, thousands of flamingos come from the coast for breeding. The pan is also rich in minerals and offers a great nutritious supplement to the all the animals. It attracts herds of antelopes and the predators that follow their prey.

Standard Version: Overnight with dinner, bed and breakfast at Mokuti Lodge.

Superior Version: Overnight with dinner, bed and breakfast at Okaukuejo Resort or similar.

Day 4: Etosha National Park - Windhoek.

(app. 420 km tarred road – app. 5 hours driving time) Lunch stop at Outjo (lunch excl.) and return to Windhoek, where we shall arrive at around 18:00.

Or

Day 4: Etosha National Park - Swakopmund.

(app. 550 km tarred road – app. 6 hours driving time)
Lunch stop at Outjo (lunch excluded) and drive via Omaruru, where we possibly stop at the local winery. Return to Swakopmund at around 18:00.
